AN ACT

To extend the authorization of use of official mail in the location and recovery of missing children, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. EXTENSION OF AUTHORIZATION OF USE OF OF-**
2 **FICIAL MAIL IN THE LOCATION AND RECOV-**
3 **ERY OF MISSING CHILDREN.**

4 The Act entitled “An Act to amend title 3, United
5 States Code, to authorize the use of penalty and franked
6 mail in efforts relating to the location and recovery of
7 missing children”, approved August 9, 1985 (39 U.S.C.
8 3220 note; Public Law 99–87), is amended—

9 (1) in section 3(a) by striking “June 30, 1997”
10 and inserting “June 30, 2002”; and

11 (2) in section 5 by striking “December 31,
12 1997” and inserting “December 31, 2002”.
