1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. DESIGNATION OF RONALD V. DELLUMS FED-**  
2 **ERAL BUILDING.**

3 The Federal building located at 1301 Clay Street in  
4 Oakland, California, shall be known and designated as the  
5 “Ronald V. Dellums Federal Building”.

6 **SEC. 2. REFERENCES.**

7 Any reference in a law, map, regulation, document,  
8 paper, or other record of the United States to the Federal  
9 building referred to in section 1 shall be deemed to be  
10 a reference to the “Ronald V. Dellums Federal Building”.
