A BILL

To amend the Act which established the Frederick Law Olmsted National Historic Site, in the Commonwealth of Massachusetts, by modifying the boundary, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*
3 That section 201 of the Act of October 12, 1979 (93 Stat.
4 664), is amended by adding at the end thereof a new sub-
5 section to read as follows:

1 “(d) In order to preserve and maintain the historic
2 setting of the Site, the Secretary is authorized to acquire,
3 through donation only, lands with associated easements
4 situated adjacent to the Site owned by the Brookline Con-
5 servation Land Trust. These lands are to be used for edu-
6 cational and interpretive purposes and shall be maintained
7 and managed as part of the Frederick Law Olmsted Na-
8 tional Historic Site.”.
