Mr. FEINGOLD introduced the following bill; which was read twice and referred to the Committee on Environment and Public Works

A BILL

To phase out Federal funding of the Tennessee Valley Authority.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. TENNESSEE VALLEY AUTHORITY.**

4 (a) DISCONTINUANCE OF APPROPRIATIONS.—Section
5 27 of the Tennessee Valley Authority Act of 1933 (16
6 U.S.C. 831z) is amended—

7 (1) by inserting “for fiscal years through fiscal
8 year 2000” before the period; and

9 (2) by adding at the end the following: “No ap-
10 propriations may be made available for the Ten-

1 Tennessee Valley Authority Environmental Research
2 Center for fiscal year 2000.”.

3 (b) PLAN.—Not later than January 1, 1998, the Di-
4 rector of the Office of Management and Budget shall de-
5 velop and submit a plan to Congress that—

6 (1) provides for the Tennessee Valley Authority
7 Environmental Research Center to make a transition
8 to sources of funds other than appropriated funds by
9 fiscal year 2000; and

10 (2) recommends any legislation that may be ap-
11 propriate to carry out the objectives of this Act.
