## A BILL

To transfer the Dillon Ranger District in the Arapaho National Forest to the White River National Forest in the State of Colorado.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. INCLUSION OF DILLON RANGER DISTRICT IN**  
2 **WHITE RIVER NATIONAL FOREST, COLO-**  
3 **RADO.**

4 (a) **BOUNDARY ADJUSTMENTS.**—

5 (1) **WHITE RIVER NATIONAL FOREST.**—The  
6 boundary of the White River National Forest in the  
7 State of Colorado is hereby adjusted to include all  
8 National Forest System lands located in Summit  
9 County, Colorado, comprising the Dillon Ranger  
10 District of the Arapaho National Forest.

11 (2) **ARAPAHO NATIONAL FOREST.**—The bound-  
12 ary of the Arapaho National Forest is adjusted to  
13 exclude the land transferred to the White River Na-  
14 tional Forest by paragraph (1).

15 (b) **REFERENCE.**—Any reference to the Dillon Rang-  
16 er District, Arapaho National Forest, in any existing stat-  
17 ute, regulation, manual, handbook, or other document  
18 shall be deemed to be a reference to the Dillon Ranger  
19 District, White River National Forest.

20 (c) **EXISTING RIGHTS.**—Nothing in this section af-  
21 fects valid existing rights of persons holding any author-  
22 ization, permit, option, or other form of contract existing  
23 on the date of the enactment of this Act.

24 (d) **FOREST RECEIPTS.**—Notwithstanding the dis-  
25 tribution requirements of payments under the sixth para-  
26 graph under the heading “FOREST SERVICE” in the

1 Act entitled “An Act making appropriations for the De-  
 2 partment of Agriculture for the fiscal year ending June  
 3 thirtieth, nineteen hundred and nine”, approved May 23,  
 4 1908 (35 Stat. 260, chapter 192; 16 U.S.C. 500), the dis-  
 5 tribution of receipts from the Arapaho National Forest  
 6 and the White River National Forest to affected county  
 7 governments shall be based on the national forest bound-  
 8 aries that existed on the day before the date of enactment  
 9 of this Act.

10 **SECTION 1. INCLUSION OF DILLON RANGER DISTRICT IN**  
 11 **WHITE RIVER NATIONAL FOREST, COLORADO.**

12 (a) *BOUNDARY ADJUSTMENTS.*—

13 (1) *WHITE RIVER NATIONAL FOREST.*—*The*  
 14 *boundary of the White River National Forest in the*  
 15 *State of Colorado is hereby adjusted to include all Na-*  
 16 *tional Forest System lands located in Summit Coun-*  
 17 *ty, Colorado, comprising the Dillon Ranger District*  
 18 *of the Arapaho National Forest.*

19 (2) *ARAPAHO NATIONAL FOREST.*—*The boundary*  
 20 *of the Arapaho National Forest is adjusted to exclude*  
 21 *the land transferred to the White River National For-*  
 22 *est by paragraph (1).*

23 (b) *REFERENCE.*—*Any reference to the Dillon Ranger*  
 24 *District, Arapaho National Forest, in any existing statute,*  
 25 *regulation, manual, handbook, or other document shall be*

1 *deemed to be a reference to the Dillon Ranger District,*  
2 *White River National Forest.*

3       (c) *EXISTING RIGHTS.*—*Nothing in this section affects*  
4 *valid existing rights of persons holding any authorization,*  
5 *permit, option, or other form of contract existing on the*  
6 *date of the enactment of this Act.*

7       (d) *FOREST RECEIPTS.*—*Notwithstanding the dis-*  
8 *tribution requirements of payments under the sixth para-*  
9 *graph under the heading “FOREST SERVICE” in the Act*  
10 *entitled “An Act making appropriations for the Depart-*  
11 *ment of Agriculture for the fiscal year ending June thirti-*  
12 *eth, nineteen hundred and nine”, approved May 23, 1908*  
13 *(35 Stat. 260, chapter 192; 16 U.S.C. 500), the distribution*  
14 *of receipts from the Arapaho National Forest and the White*  
15 *River National Forest to affected county governments shall*  
16 *be based on the national forest boundaries that existed on*  
17 *the day before the date of enactment of this Act.*
