Mr. WARNER submitted the following concurrent resolution; which was considered and agreed to

## CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

To authorize the printing of copies of the publication entitled “The United States Capitol” as a Senate document.

1        *Resolved by the Senate (the House of Representatives*  
2        *concurring)*, That (a) a revised edition of the publication  
3        entitled “The United States Capitol” (referred to as “the  
4        pamphlet”) shall be reprinted as a Senate document.

5        (b) There shall be printed 2,000,000 copies of the  
6        pamphlet in the English language at a cost not to exceed  
7        \$100,000 for distribution as follows:

8                (1)(A) 206,000 copies of the publication for the  
9        use of the Senate with 2,000 copies distributed to  
10       each Member;

1           (B) 886,000 copies of the publication for the  
2 use of the House of Representatives, with 2,000 cop-  
3 ies distributed to each Member; and

4           (C) 908,000 of the publication for distribution  
5 to the Capitol Guide Service; or

6           (2) if the total printing and production costs of  
7 copies in paragraph (1) exceed \$100,000, such num-  
8 ber of copies of the publication as does not exceed  
9 total printing and production costs of \$100,000,  
10 with distribution to be allocated in the same propor-  
11 tion as in paragraph (1).

12          (c) In addition to the copies printed pursuant to sub-  
13 section (b), there shall be printed at a total printing and  
14 production cost of not to exceed \$70,000—

15           (1) 50,000 copies of the pamphlet in each of  
16 the following 5 languages: German, French, Rus-  
17 sian, Chinese, and Japanese; and

18           (2) 100,000 copies of the pamphlet in Spanish;  
19 to be distributed to the Capitol Guide Service.
