## RESOLUTION

To permit an individual with a disability with access to  
the Senate floor to bring necessary supporting aids and  
services.

1       *Resolved*, That an individual with a disability who has  
2 or is granted the privilege of the Senate floor under rule  
3 XXIII of the Standing Rules of the Senate may bring nec-  
4 essary supporting aids and services (including service  
5 dogs, wheelchairs, and interpreters) on the Senate floor,  
6 unless the Senate Sergeant at Arms determines that the  
7 use of such supporting aids and services would place a  
8 significant difficulty or expense on the operations of the  
9 Senate in accordance with paragraph 2 of rule 4 of the
