## AN ACT

To designate certain facilities of the United States Postal  
Service in Chicago, Illinois.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. CARDISS COLLINS POST OFFICE BUILDING.**

2 (a) DESIGNATION.—The facility of the United States  
3 Postal Service located at 433 West Harrison Street in Chi-  
4 cago, Illinois, is hereby designated as the “Cardiss Collins  
5 Post Office Building”.

6 (b) REFERENCES.—Any reference to such facility in  
7 a law, regulation, map, document, paper, or other record  
8 of the United States shall be considered to be a reference  
9 to the “Cardiss Collins Post Office Building”.

10 **SEC. 2. OTIS GRANT COLLINS POST OFFICE BUILDING.**

11 (a) DESIGNATION.—The facility of the United States  
12 Postal Service located at 2302 South Pulaski Street in  
13 Chicago, Illinois, is hereby designated as the “Otis Grant  
14 Collins Post Office Building”.

15 (b) REFERENCES.—Any reference to such facility in  
16 a law, regulation, map, document, paper, or other record  
17 of the United States shall be considered to be a reference  
18 to the “Otis Grant Collins Post Office Building”.

19 **SEC. 3. MARY ALICE (MA) HENRY POST OFFICE BUILDING.**

20 (a) DESIGNATION.—The facility of the United States  
21 Postal Service located at 4222 West Madison Street in  
22 Chicago, Illinois, is hereby designated as the “Mary Alice  
23 (Ma) Henry Post Office Building”.

24 (b) REFERENCES.—Any reference to such facility in  
25 a law, regulation, map, document, paper, or other record

1 of the United States shall be considered to be a reference  
2 to the “Mary Alice (Ma) Henry Post Office Building”.

3 **SEC. 4. ROBERT LEFLORE, JR. POST OFFICE BUILDING.**

4 (a) DESIGNATION.—The facility of the United States  
5 Postal Service located at 50001 West Division Street in  
6 Chicago, Illinois, is hereby designated as the “Robert  
7 LeFlore, Jr. Post Office Building”.

8 (b) REFERENCES.—Any reference to such facility in  
9 a law, regulation, map, document, paper, or other record  
10 of the United States shall be considered to be a reference  
11 to the “Robert LeFlore, Jr. Post Office Building”.
