A BILL

To provide for the relief of Kathy Barrett.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. CHARGING OF EXCESS EARNINGS TO ALL**
4 **MONTHS IN THE TAXABLE YEAR.**

5 Notwithstanding section 203(f) of the Social Security
6 Act, the amount of excess earnings with which Kathy Bar-
7 rett of Debra Road in Pembroke, Massachusetts, is
8 charged for each month in a taxable year for purposes of
9 section 203(b) of such Act shall be equal to $\frac{1}{12}$ of the
10 total amount of her excess earnings, if any, which would

- 1 be charged to months in the entire taxable year under such
- 2 section 203(f) in the absence of this section.
