5 The building at 8725 John J. Kingman Road, Fort
6 Belvoir, Virginia, shall after the date of the enactment of
7 this Act be known and designated as the “Andrew T.
8 McNamara Building”. Any reference to that building in
9 any law, regulation, map, document, record, or other

1 paper of the United States shall be considered to be a ref-
2 erence to the Andrew T. McNamara Building.
