## A BILL

For the relief of Akal Security, Incorporated.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. PAYMENT FOR SERVICES PERFORMED BUT**

4 **NOT PAID.**

5 Notwithstanding section 2465 of title 10, United  
6 States Code, the Secretary of the Treasury shall pay, out  
7 of any money in the Treasury not otherwise appropriated,  
8 to Akal Security, Incorporated, a New Mexico corporation

1 incorporated in New Mexico, \$10,208.74 for security  
2 guard services rendered in 1991 to the United States  
3 Army Reserve Personnel Center located at 9700 Page  
4 Boulevard in St. Louis, Missouri.

5 **SEC. 2. EXTINGUISHMENT OF LIABILITY.**

6 Notwithstanding section 2465 of title 10, United  
7 States Code, any liability of Akal Security, Incorporated,  
8 to the United States for repayment of \$57,771.29 for the  
9 services described in section 1 is hereby extinguished.

10 **SEC. 3. FULL SATISFACTION.**

11 The relief under sections 1 and 2 shall, when accept-  
12 ed by or on behalf of Akal Security, Incorporated, be in  
13 full satisfaction of all claims of or on behalf of Akal Secu-  
14 rity, Incorporated, against the United States or against  
15 any officer, employee, or agent of the United States acting  
16 within the scope of employment or agency, for payment  
17 for the services described in section 1.

18 **SEC. 4. LIMITATION ON ATTORNEY FEES.**

19 It shall be unlawful for an amount exceeding 10 per-  
20 cent of the amount paid pursuant to section 1 to be paid  
21 to, or received by, any agent or attorney for any service  
22 rendered in connection with the claim described in such  
23 section. Any person who violates this section shall be  
24 guilty of an infraction, and shall be subject to a fine in  
25 the amount provided in title 18, United States Code.
