3 **SECTION 1. VESSEL MIST COVE.**

4 (a) CONSTRUCTION TONNAGE OF M/V MIST
5 COVE.—The M/V MIST COVE (United States official
6 number 1085817) is deemed to be less than 100 gross

1 tons, as measured under chapter 145 of title 46, United
2 States Code, for purposes of applying the optional regu-
3 latory measurement under section 14305 of that title.

4 (b) LIMITATION ON APPLICATION.—Subsection (a)
5 shall not apply on any date on which the length of the
6 vessel exceeds 157 feet.
