1 **SECTION 1. MANDATORY SEPARATION AGE FOR FIRE-**
2 **FIGHTERS.**

3 (a) CIVIL SERVICE RETIREMENT SYSTEM.—

4 (1) IN GENERAL.—The second sentence of sec-
5 tion 8335(b) of title 5, United States Code, is
6 amended—

7 (A) by inserting “, firefighter,” after “law
8 enforcement officer”; and

9 (B) by inserting “, firefighter,” after “that
10 officer”.

11 (2) CONFORMING AMENDMENT.—Section
12 8335(b) of title 5, United States Code, is amended
13 by striking the first sentence.

14 (b) FEDERAL EMPLOYEES’ RETIREMENT SYSTEM.—

15 (1) IN GENERAL.—The second sentence of sec-
16 tion 8425(b) of title 5, United States Code, is
17 amended—

18 (A) by inserting “, firefighter,” after “law
19 enforcement officer”; and

20 (B) by inserting “, firefighter,” after “that
21 officer”.

1 (2) CONFORMING AMENDMENT.—Section
2 8425(b) of title 5, United States Code, is amended
3 by striking the first sentence.
