A BILL

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. GERTRUDE A. BARBER POST OFFICE BUILDING.**

4 (a) DESIGNATION.—The facility of the United States
5 Postal Service located at 2108 East 38th Street in Erie,
6 Pennsylvania, shall be known and designated as the “Ger-
7 trude A. Barber Post Office Building”.

1 (b) REFERENCES.—Any reference in a law, map, reg-
2 ulation, document, paper, or other record of the United
3 States to the facility referred to in subsection (a) shall
4 be deemed to be a reference to the “Gertrude A. Barber
5 Post Office Building”.
