Mr. HUTCHINSON introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on Transportation and Infrastructure

A BILL

To amend title 23, United States Code, to require States to provide Federal highway funds for projects in high priority corridors, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Priority Corridor Eq-
5 uity Act of 2000”.

6 **SEC. 2. REVENUE ALIGNED BUDGET AUTHORITY.**

7 Subsection (c) of section 110 of title 23, United
8 States Code, relating to revenue aligned budget authority,
9 is amended—

1 (1) by striking “Of the funds” and inserting
2 the following:

3 “(1) IN GENERAL.—Of the funds”;

4 (2) by adding at the end the following:

5 “(2) SPECIAL RULE.—Notwithstanding para-
6 graph (1), if, in a fiscal year beginning after Sep-
7 tember 30, 1999, a State has within its boundaries
8 1 or more high priority corridors identified in section
9 1105(c) of the Intermodal Surface Transportation
10 Efficiency Act of 1991 and the State does not obli-
11 gate on projects described in section 103(b)(6)(A)
12 an aggregate amount that equals or exceeds the less-
13 er of 10 percent of the aggregate amount of funds
14 apportioned to the State under this chapter or the
15 total amount necessary to complete construction of
16 any incomplete projects described in section
17 103(b)(6)(A) in such corridors, the State may only
18 obligate funds allocated to the State under sub-
19 section (b)(4) for the succeeding fiscal year on
20 projects described in section 103(b)(6)(A) in such
21 corridors.”; and

22 (3) by aligning the remainder of paragraph (1)
23 (as designated by paragraph (1) of this section) with

- 1 paragraph (2) of such subsection (as added by para-
- 2 graph (2) of this section).
