A BILL

To redesignate the facility of the United States Postal Service located at 1568 South Glen Road in South Euclid, Ohio, as the “Arnold C. D’Amico Station”.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. ARNOLD C. D’AMICO STATION.**

4 (a) DESIGNATION.—The facility of the United States
5 Postal Service located at 1568 South Glen Road in South
6 Euclid, Ohio, and known as the South Euclid Station,

1 shall be known and designated as the “Arnold C. D’Amico
2 Station”.

3 (b) REFERENCES.—Any reference in a law, map, reg-
4 ulation, document, paper, or other record of the United
5 States to the facility referred to in subsection (a) shall
6 be deemed to be a reference to the “Arnold C. D’Amico
7 Station”.
