3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Nazi and Japanese
5 War Crimes Disclosure Act of 2000”.

1 **SEC. 2. AMENDMENTS TO NAZI WAR CRIMES DISCLOSURE**
2 **ACT.**

3 (a) **EXTENSION OF INTERAGENCY WORKING**
4 **GROUP.**—Section 2(b)(1) of the Nazi War Crimes Dislo-
5 sure Act (Pub. Law 105–246; 5 U.S.C. 552 note) is
6 amended by striking “3 years” and inserting “5 years”.

7 (b) **CLARIFICATION REGARDING RECORDS RELATED**
8 **TO IMPERIAL GOVERNMENT OF JAPAN.**—Section 3(a) of
9 such Act is amended—

10 (1) in paragraph (1)(D) by inserting “, includ-
11 ing the Imperial Government of Japan” after “ally
12 of the Nazi government of Germany”; and

13 (2) in paragraph (2)(A) by inserting “, includ-
14 ing the Imperial Government of Japan” after “allied
15 with that government”.
