A BILL

To provide for the opposition of the United States to the provision of any resources or assistance by the International Monetary Fund to the Palestinian Authority until the Secretary of State certifies that Israel and the Palestinian Authority have signed an agreement on borders and security arrangements for Israel and a Palestinian state.

1 **SECTION 1. OPPOSITION OF THE UNITED STATES TO THE**
2 **PROVISION OF ANY RESOURCES OR ASSIST-**
3 **ANCE BY THE INTERNATIONAL MONETARY**
4 **FUND TO THE PALESTINIAN AUTHORITY**
5 **UNTIL ISRAEL AND THE PALESTINIAN AU-**
6 **THORITY AGREE ON BORDERS AND SECU-**
7 **RITY ARRANGEMENTS.**

8 The Bretton Woods Agreements Act (22 U.S.C. 286–
9 286nn) is amended by adding at the end the following:

10 **“SEC. 63. OPPOSITION OF THE UNITED STATES TO THE**
11 **PROVISION OF ANY RESOURCES OR ASSIST-**
12 **ANCE BY THE INTERNATIONAL MONETARY**
13 **FUND TO THE PALESTINIAN AUTHORITY**
14 **UNTIL ISRAEL AND THE PALESTINIAN AU-**
15 **THORITY AGREE ON BORDERS AND SECU-**
16 **RITY ARRANGEMENTS.**

17 “The Secretary of the Treasury shall instruct the
18 United States Executive Director at the Fund to use the
19 voice, vote, and influence of the United States to oppose
20 the provision of any resources or assistance by the Fund
21 to the Palestinian Authority, until the Secretary of State
22 certifies to the Congress that Israel and the Palestinian
23 Authority have signed an agreement on borders and secu-
24 rity arrangements for Israel and a Palestinian state.”.
