Mrs. MYRICK, from the Committee on Rules, reported the following resolution; which was referred to the House Calendar and ordered to be printed

RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 1664) making emergency supplemental appropriations for military operations, refugee relief, and humanitarian assistance relating to the conflict in Kosovo, and for military operations in Southwest Asia for the fiscal year ending September 30, 1999, and for other purposes.

- 1 *Resolved*, That at any time after the adoption of this
- 2 resolution the Speaker may, pursuant to clause 2(b) of
- 3 rule XVIII, declare the House resolved into the Committee

1 of the Whole House on the state of the Union for consider-
2 ation of the bill (H.R. 1664) making emergency supple-
3 mental appropriations for military operations, refugee re-
4 lief, and humanitarian assistance relating to the conflict
5 in Kosovo, and for military operations in Southwest Asia
6 for the fiscal year ending September 30, 1999, and for
7 other purposes. The first reading of the bill shall be dis-
8 pensed with. Points of order against consideration of the
9 bill for failure to comply with clause 4 of rule XIII or
10 section 306 of the Congressional Budget Act of 1974 are
11 waived. General debate shall be confined to the bill and
12 shall not exceed one hour equally divided and controlled
13 by the chairman and ranking minority member of the
14 Committee on Appropriations. After general debate the
15 bill shall be considered for amendment under the five-
16 minute rule. Points of order against provisions in the bill
17 for failure to comply with clause 2 of rule XXI are waived.
18 Before consideration of any other amendment it shall be
19 in order to consider the amendments printed in the report
20 of the Committee on Rules accompanying this resolution.
21 Each amendment printed in the report may be considered
22 only in the order printed in the report, may be offered
23 only by a Member designated in the report, shall be con-
24 sidered as read, shall be debatable for the time specified
25 in the report equally divided and controlled by the pro-

1 ponent and an opponent, shall not be subject to amend-
2 ment, and shall not be subject to a demand for division
3 of the question in the House or in the Committee of the
4 Whole. All points of order against the amendments printed
5 in the report are waived. During consideration of the bill
6 for further amendment, the chairman of the Committee
7 of the Whole may accord priority in recognition on the
8 basis of whether the Member offering an amendment has
9 caused it to be printed in the portion of the Congressional
10 Record designated for that purpose in clause 8 of rule
11 XVIII. Amendments so printed shall be considered as
12 read. The chairman of the Committee of the Whole may:
13 (1) postpone until a time during further consideration in
14 the Committee of the Whole a request for a recorded vote
15 on any amendment; and (2) reduce to five minutes the
16 minimum time for electronic voting on any postponed
17 question that follows another electronic vote without inter-
18 vening business, provided that the minimum time for elec-
19 tronic voting on the first in any series of questions shall
20 be 15 minutes. During consideration of the bill, points of
21 order against amendments for failure to comply with
22 clause 2(e) of rule XXI are waived. At the conclusion of
23 consideration of the bill for amendment the Committee
24 shall rise and report the bill to the House with such
25 amendments as may have been adopted. The previous

1 question shall be considered as ordered on the bill and
2 amendments thereto to final passage without intervening
3 motion except one motion to recommit with or without in-
4 structions.
