RESOLUTION

Providing for the consideration of the Senate amendment to the bill (H.R. 4) to declare it to be the policy of the United States to deploy a national missile system.

1 *Resolved*, That upon adoption of this resolution it
2 shall be in order to take from the Speaker's table the bill
3 (H.R. 4) to declare it to be the policy of the United States
4 to deploy a national missile defense, with a Senate amend-
5 ment thereto, and to consider in the House a motion of-
6 fered by the chairman of the Committee on Armed Serv-
7 ices or his designee to concur in the Senate amendment.

1 The Senate amendment and the motion shall be consid-
2 ered as read. The motion shall be debatable for one hour
3 equally divided and controlled by the chairman and rank-
4 ing minority member of the Committee on Armed Services.
5 The previous question shall be considered as ordered on
6 the motion to final adoption without intervening motion.
