Mr. HASTINGS of Washington, from the Committee on Rules, reported the following resolution; which was referred to the House Calendar and ordered to be printed

RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 592) to redesignate Great Kills Park in the Gateway National Recreation Area as “World War II Veterans Park at Great Kills”.

1 *Resolved*, That at any time after the adoption of this
2 resolution the Speaker may, pursuant to clause 2(b) of
3 rule XVIII, declare the House resolved into the Committee
4 of the Whole House on the state of the Union for consider-
5 ation of the bill (H.R. 592) to redesignate Great Kills

1 Park in the Gateway National Recreation Area as “World
2 War II Veterans Park at Great Kills”. The first reading
3 of the bill shall be dispensed with. General debate shall
4 be confined to the bill and shall not exceed one hour equal-
5 ly divided and controlled by the chairman and ranking mi-
6 nority member of the Committee on Resources. After gen-
7 eral debate the bill shall be considered for amendment
8 under the five-minute rule. It shall be in order to consider
9 as an original bill for the purpose of amendment under
10 the five-minute rule the amendment in the nature of a sub-
11 stitute recommended by the Committee on Resources now
12 printed in the bill. The committee amendment in the na-
13 ture of a substitute shall be considered as read. Points
14 of order against the committee amendment for failure to
15 comply with clause 7 of rule XVI are waived. During con-
16 sideration of the bill for amendment, the Chairman of the
17 Committee of the Whole may accord priority in recognition
18 on the basis of whether the Member offering an amend-
19 ment has caused it to be printed in the portion of the Con-
20 gressional Record designated for that purpose in clause
21 8 of rule XVIII. Amendments so printed shall be consid-
22 ered as read. The Chairman of the Committee of the
23 Whole may: (1) postpone until a time during further con-
24 sideration in the Committee of the Whole a request for
25 a recorded vote on any amendment; and (2) reduce to five

1 minutes the minimum time for electronic voting on any
2 postponed question that follows another electronic vote
3 without intervening business, provided that the minimum
4 time for electronic voting on the first in any series of ques-
5 tions shall be 15 minutes. At the conclusion of consider-
6 ation of the bill for amendment the Committee shall rise
7 and report the bill to the House with such amendments
8 as may have been adopted. Any Member may demand a
9 separate vote in the House on any amendment adopted
10 in the Committee of the Whole to the bill or to the com-
11 mittee amendment in the nature of a substitute. The pre-
12 vious question shall be considered as ordered on the bill
13 and amendments thereto to final passage without inter-
14 vening motion except one motion to recommit with or
15 without instructions.
