Mr. HASTINGS of Washington, from the Committee on Rules, reported the following resolution; which was referred to the House Calendar and ordered to be printed

RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 1695) to provide for the conveyance of certain Federal public lands in the Ivanpah Valley, Nevada, to Clark County, Nevada, for the development of an airport facility, and for other purposes.

1 *Resolved*, That at any time after the adoption of this
2 resolution the Speaker may, pursuant to clause 2(b) of
3 rule XVIII, declare the House resolved into the Committee
4 of the Whole House on the state of the Union for consider-

1 ation of the bill (H.R. 1695) to provide for the conveyance
2 of certain Federal public lands in the Ivanpah Valley, Ne-
3 vada, to Clark County, Nevada, for the development of an
4 airport facility, and for other purposes. The first reading
5 of the bill shall be dispensed with. All points of order
6 against consideration of the bill are waived. General de-
7 bate shall be confined to the bill and shall not exceed one
8 hour equally divided and controlled by the chairman and
9 ranking minority member of the Committee on Resources.
10 After general debate the bill shall be considered for
11 amendment under the five-minute rule. It shall be in order
12 to consider as an original bill for the purpose of amend-
13 ment under the five-minute rule the amendment in the na-
14 ture of a substitute recommended by the Committee on
15 Resources now printed in the bill. The committee amend-
16 ment in the nature of a substitute shall be considered as
17 read. All points of order against the committee amend-
18 ment in the nature of a substitute are waived. The amend-
19 ment printed in the report of the Committee on Rules ac-
20 companying this resolution shall be considered as read and
21 shall not be subject to a demand for division of the ques-
22 tion in the House or in the Committee of the Whole. Dur-
23 ing consideration of the bill for amendment, the Chairman
24 of the Committee of the Whole may accord priority in rec-
25 ognition on the basis of whether the Member offering an

1 amendment has caused it to be printed in the portion of
2 the Congressional Record designated for that purpose in
3 clause 8 of rule XVIII. Amendments so printed shall be
4 considered as read. The Chairman of the Committee of
5 the Whole may: (1) postpone until a time during further
6 consideration in the Committee of the Whole a request for
7 a recorded vote on any amendment; and (2) reduce to five
8 minutes the minimum time for electronic voting on any
9 postponed question that follows another electronic vote
10 without intervening business, provided that the minimum
11 time for electronic voting on the first in any series of ques-
12 tions shall be 15 minutes. At the conclusion of consider-
13 ation of the bill for amendment the Committee shall rise
14 and report the bill to the House with such amendments
15 as may have been adopted. Any Member may demand a
16 separate vote in the House on any amendment adopted
17 in the Committee of the Whole to the bill or to the com-
18 mittee amendment in the nature of a substitute. The pre-
19 vious question shall be considered as ordered on the bill
20 and amendments thereto to final passage without inter-
21 vening motion except one motion to recommit with or
22 without instructions.
