Mr. GOSS, from the Committee on Rules, reported the following resolution; which was referred to the House Calendar and ordered to be printed

---

# RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 3908) making emergency supplemental appropriations for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2000, and for other purposes.

1       *Resolved*, That at any time after the adoption of this  
2 resolution the Speaker may, pursuant to clause 2(b) of  
3 rule XVIII, declare the House resolved into the Committee  
4 of the Whole House on the state of the Union for consider-  
5 ation of the bill (H.R. 3908) making emergency supple-  
6 mental appropriations for the fiscal year ending Sep-  
7 tember 30, 2000, and for other purposes. The first reading

1 of the bill shall be dispensed with. All points of order  
2 against consideration of the bill are waived. General de-  
3 bate shall be confined to the bill and shall not exceed one  
4 hour equally divided and controlled by the chairman and  
5 ranking minority member of the Committee on Appropria-  
6 tions. After general debate the bill shall be considered for  
7 amendment under the five-minute rule. Points of order  
8 against provisions in the bill for failure to comply with  
9 clause 2 of rule XXI are waived except as follows: page  
10 58, lines 9 through 17. Before consideration of any other  
11 amendment it shall be in order to consider the amend-  
12 ments printed in part A of the report of the Committee  
13 on Rules accompanying this resolution. Each amendment  
14 printed in part A of the report may be considered only  
15 in the order printed in the report. The amendments print-  
16 ed in part B of the report of the Committee on Rules may  
17 be offered only at the appropriate point in the reading of  
18 the bill. The amendments printed in the report of the  
19 Committee on Rules may be offered only by a Member  
20 designated in the report, shall be considered as read, shall  
21 be debatable for the time specified in the report equally  
22 divided and controlled by the proponent and an opponent,  
23 shall not be subject to amendment, and shall not be sub-  
24 ject to a demand for division of the question in the House  
25 or in the Committee of the Whole. All points of order

1 against the amendments printed in the report are waived.  
2 During consideration of the bill for further amendment,  
3 the Chairman of the Committee of the Whole may accord  
4 priority in recognition on the basis of whether the Member  
5 offering an amendment has caused it to be printed in the  
6 portion of the Congressional Record designated for that  
7 purpose in clause 8 of rule XVIII. Amendments so printed  
8 shall be considered as read. The Chairman of the Com-  
9 mittee of the Whole may: (1) postpone until a time during  
10 further consideration in the Committee of the Whole a re-  
11 quest for a recorded vote on any amendment; and (2) re-  
12 duce to five minutes the minimum time for electronic vot-  
13 ing on any postponed question that follows another elec-  
14 tronic vote without intervening business, provided that the  
15 minimum time for electronic voting on the first in any se-  
16 ries of questions shall be 15 minutes. During consideration  
17 of the bill, points of order against amendments for failure  
18 to comply with clause 2(e) of rule XXI are waived. At the  
19 conclusion of consideration of the bill for amendment the  
20 Committee shall rise and report the bill to the House with  
21 such amendments as may have been adopted. The previous  
22 question shall be considered as ordered on the bill and  
23 amendments thereto to final passage without intervening  
24 motion except one motion to recommit with or without in-  
25 structions.
