Mr. REYNOLDS, from the Committee on Rules, reported the following resolution; which was referred to the House Calendar and ordered to be printed

RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 3039) to amend the Federal Water Pollution Control Act to assist in the restoration of the Chesapeake Bay, and for other purposes.

1 *Resolved*, That at any time after the adoption of this
2 resolution the Speaker may, pursuant to clause 2(b) of
3 rule XVIII, declare the House resolved into the Committee
4 of the Whole House on the state of the Union for consider-
5 ation of the bill (H.R. 3039) to amend the Federal Water
6 Pollution Control Act to assist in the restoration of the

1 Chesapeake Bay, and for other purposes. The first reading
2 of the bill shall be dispensed with. General debate shall
3 be confined to the bill and shall not exceed one hour equal-
4 ly divided and controlled by the chairman and ranking mi-
5 nority member of the Committee on Transportation and
6 Infrastructure. After general debate the bill shall be con-
7 sidered for amendment under the five-minute rule. The bill
8 shall be considered as read. During consideration of the
9 bill for amendment, the Chairman of the Committee of
10 the Whole may accord priority in recognition on the basis
11 of whether the Member offering an amendment has caused
12 it to be printed in the portion of the Congressional Record
13 designated for that purpose in clause 8 of rule XVIII.
14 Amendments so printed shall be considered as read. The
15 Chairman of the Committee of the Whole may: (1) post-
16 pone until a time during further consideration in the Com-
17 mittee of the Whole a request for a recorded vote on any
18 amendment; and (2) reduce to five minutes the minimum
19 time for electronic voting on any postponed question that
20 follows another electronic vote without intervening busi-
21 ness, provided that the minimum time for electronic voting
22 on the first in any series of questions shall be 15 minutes.
23 At the conclusion of consideration of the bill for amend-
24 ment the Committee shall rise and report the bill to the
25 House with such amendments as may have been adopted.

1 The previous question shall be considered as ordered on
2 the bill and amendments thereto to final passage without
3 intervening motion except one motion to recommit with
4 or without instructions.
