Ms. PRYCE of Ohio, from the Committee on Rules, reported the following resolution; which was referred to the House Calendar and ordered to be printed

## RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 4577) making appropriations for the Departments of Labor, Health and Human Services, and Education, and related agencies for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2001, and for other purposes.

1       *Resolved*, That at any time after the adoption of this  
2 resolution the Speaker may, pursuant to clause 2(b) of  
3 rule XVIII, declare the House resolved into the Committee  
4 of the Whole House on the state of the Union for consider-

1 ation of the bill (H.R. 4577) making appropriations for  
2 the Departments of Labor, Health and Human Services,  
3 and Education, and related agencies for the fiscal year  
4 ending September 30, 2001, and for other purposes. The  
5 first reading of the bill shall be dispensed with. All points  
6 of order against consideration of the bill are waived. Gen-  
7 eral debate shall be confined to the bill and shall not ex-  
8 ceed one hour equally divided and controlled by the chair-  
9 man and ranking minority member of the Committee on  
10 Appropriations. After general debate the bill shall be con-  
11 sidered for amendment under the five-minute rule. The  
12 amendments printed in part A of the report of the Com-  
13 mittee on Rules accompanying this resolution shall be con-  
14 sidered as adopted in the House and in the Committee  
15 of the Whole. Points of order against provisions in the  
16 bill, as amended, for failure to comply with clause 2 of  
17 rule XXI are waived except as follows: beginning with “:  
18 *Provided*” on page 44, line 4, through “as amended” on  
19 line 14. Where points of order are waived against part  
20 of a paragraph, points of order against a provision in an-  
21 other part of such paragraph may be made only against  
22 such provision and not against the entire paragraph. The  
23 amendment printed in part B of the report of the Com-  
24 mittee on Rules may be offered only by a Member des-  
25 igned in the report and only at the appropriate point

1 in the reading of the bill, shall be considered as read, shall  
2 be debatable for the time specified in the report equally  
3 divided and controlled by the proponent and an opponent,  
4 shall not be subject to amendment, and shall not be sub-  
5 ject to a demand for division of the question in the House  
6 or in the Committee of the Whole. All points of order  
7 against the amendment printed in part B of the report  
8 are waived. During consideration of the bill for further  
9 amendment, the Chairman of the Committee of the Whole  
10 may accord priority in recognition on the basis of whether  
11 the Member offering an amendment has caused it to be  
12 printed in the portion of the Congressional Record des-  
13 ignated for that purpose in clause 8 of rule XVIII. Amend-  
14 ments so printed shall be considered as read. The Chair-  
15 man of the Committee of the Whole may : (1) postpone  
16 until a time during further consideration in the Committee  
17 of the Whole a request for a recorded vote on any amend-  
18 ment; and (2) reduce to five minutes the minimum time  
19 for electronic voting on any postponed question that fol-  
20 lows another electronic vote without intervening business,  
21 provided that the minimum time for electronic voting on  
22 the first in any series of questions shall be 15 minutes.  
23 During consideration of the bill, points of order against  
24 amendments for failure to comply with clause 2(e) of rule  
25 XXI are waived. At the conclusion of consideration of the

1 bill for amendment the Committee shall rise and report  
2 the bill, as amended, to the House with such further  
3 amendments as may have been adopted. The previous  
4 question shall be considered as ordered on the bill and  
5 amendments thereto to final passage without intervening  
6 motion except one motion to recommit with or without in-  
7 structions.
