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## AN ACT

To clarify certain boundaries on maps relating to the Coastal  
Barrier Resources System.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. REPLACEMENT OF COASTAL BARRIER RE-**  
 2 **SOURCES SYSTEM MAPS.**

3 (a) IN GENERAL.—The 7 maps described in sub-  
 4 section (b) are replaced by 14 maps entitled “Dare Coun-  
 5 ty, North Carolina, Coastal Barrier Resources System,  
 6 Cape Hatteras Unit NC–03P” or “Dare County, North  
 7 Carolina, Coastal Barrier Resources System, Cape Hat-  
 8 teras Unit NC–03P, Hatteras Island Unit L03” and dated  
 9 October 18, 1999.

10 (b) DESCRIPTION OF MAPS.—The maps described in  
 11 this subsection are the 7 maps that—

12 (1) relate to the portions of Cape Hatteras Unit  
 13 NC–03P and Hatteras Island Unit L03 that are lo-  
 14 cated in Dare County, North Carolina; and

15 (2) are included in a set of maps entitled  
 16 “Coastal Barrier Resources System”, dated October  
 17 24, 1990, and referred to in section 4(a) of the  
 18 Coastal Barrier Resources Act (16 U.S.C. 3503(a)).

19 (c) AVAILABILITY.—The Secretary of the Interior  
 20 shall keep the maps referred to in subsection (a) on file  
 21 and available for inspection in accordance with section  
 22 4(b) of the Coastal Barrier Resources Act (16 U.S.C.  
 23 3503(b)).
