## A BILL

To designate certain facilities of the United States Postal Service.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3       **SECTION 1. JOEL T. BROYHILL POSTAL BUILDING.**

4       (a) DESIGNATION.—The facility of the United States  
5       Postal Service located at 8409 Lee Highway in Merrifield,  
6       Virginia, shall be known and designated as the “Joel T.  
7       Broyhill Postal Building”.

8       (b) REFERENCES.—Any reference in a law, map, reg-  
9       ulation, document, paper, or other record of the United  
10      States to the facility referred to in subsection (a) shall

1 be deemed to be a reference to the “Joel T. Broyhill Postal  
2 Building”.

3 **SEC. 2. JOSEPH L. FISHER POST OFFICE.**

4 (a) DESIGNATION.—The facility of the United States  
5 Postal Service located at 3118 Washington Boulevard in  
6 Arlington, Virginia, shall be known and designated as the  
7 “Joseph L. Fisher Post Office”.

8 (b) REFERENCES.—Any reference in a law, map, reg-  
9 ulation, document, paper, or other record of the United  
10 States to the facility referred to in subsection (a) shall  
11 be deemed to be a reference to the “Joseph L. Fisher Post  
12 Office”.
