## A BILL

To permit the catcher vessel HAZEL LORRAINE to conduct commercial fishing activities.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. TREATMENT OF VESSEL AS AN ELIGIBLE**  
4 **VESSEL.**

5 Notwithstanding paragraphs (1) through (3) of sec-  
6 tion 208(a) of the American Fisheries Act (title II of divi-  
7 sion C of the Omnibus Consolidated and Emergency Sup-  
8 plemental Appropriations Act, 1999 (Public Law 105-  
9 277; 112 Stat. 2681–624)), the catcher vessel HAZEL  
10 LORRAINE (United States Official Number 592211)

1 shall be considered to be a vessel that is eligible to harvest  
2 the directed fishing allowance under section 206(b)(1) of  
3 that Act pursuant to a Federal fishing permit in the same  
4 manner as, and subject to the same requirements and limi-  
5 tations on that harvesting as apply to, catcher vessels that  
6 are eligible to harvest that directed fishing allowance  
7 under section 208(a) of that Act.
