Mr. MURKOWSKI introduced the following bill; which was read twice and referred to the Committee on Energy and Natural Resources

A BILL

To convey certain real property located in Tongass National Forest to Daniel J. Gross, Sr., and Douglas K. Gross, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Heritage Land Trans-
5 fer Act of 2000”.

6 **SEC. 2. CONVEYANCE TO DANIEL AND DOUGLASS GROSS.**

7 (a) IN GENERAL.—The Secretary of Agriculture
8 shall—

1 (1) survey certain real property located in
2 Tongass National Forest and described in subsection
3 (b); and

4 (2) convey all right, title, and interest in and to
5 Daniel J. Gross, Sr., and Douglas K. Gross, of
6 Wrangell, Alaska, subject to the provision of sub-
7 section (c) without further consideration.

8 (b) DESCRIPTION.—The real property referred to in
9 subsection (a)—

10 (1) consists of approximately 160.8 acres;

11 (2) is located at Green Point on the Stikine
12 River in Alaska; and

13 (3) has the legal description T61S R84E S31,
14 NE¹/₄, NW¹/₄ and NW¹/₄, NE¹/₄, Copper River Me-
15 ridian.

16 (c) COST.—All costs associated with the survey and
17 transfer of the property shall be paid by the Secretary of
18 Agriculture.

19 (d) APPROPRIATION.—There is authorized to be ap-
20 propriated such sums as may be necessary to carry out
21 the purposes of this Act.
