5 Section 4(e) of the Federal Power Act (16 U.S.C.
6 797(e)) is amended in the first sentence by striking “sev-
7 eral States, or upon” and inserting “several States (except

1 fresh waters in the State of Hawaii, unless a license would
2 be required under section 23), or upon”.
