1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. IMPACT AID.**

4 The Secretary of Education shall deem as timely
5 filed, and shall process for payment, an application for a
6 fiscal year 1999 payment under section 8003 of the Ele-
7 mentary and Secondary Education Act of 1965 (20 U.S.C.
8 7703) from a local educational agency serving each of the
9 following school districts if the Secretary receives that ap-

1 plication not later than 30 days after the date of enact-
2 ment of this Act:

3 (1) The Dodson Elementary School District
4 #2, Montana.

5 (2) The Dodson High School District, Montana.

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
