A BILL

For the relief of Saeed Rezai.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. PERMANENT RESIDENCE.**

4 Notwithstanding any other provision of law, for pur-
5 poses of the Immigration and Nationality Act (8 U.S.C.
6 1101 et seq.), Saeed Rezai shall be held and considered
7 to have been lawfully admitted to the United States for
8 permanent residence as of the date of the enactment of
9 this Act upon payment of the required visa fee.

1 **SEC. 2. REDUCTION OF NUMBER OF AVAILABLE VISAS.**

2 Upon the granting of permanent residence to Saeed
3 Rezai as provided in this Act, the Secretary of State shall
4 instruct the proper officer to reduce by one number during
5 the current fiscal year the total number of immigrant visas
6 available to natives of the country of the alien's birth
7 under section 203(a) of the Immigration and Nationality
8 Act (8 U.S.C. 1153(a)).
