3 **SECTION 1. DISTRICT JUDGESHIPS IN NORTH CAROLINA.**

4 Section 133(a) of title 28, United States Code, is  
5 amended in the table by striking the item relating to  
6 North Carolina and inserting the following:

“North Carolina:  
“Eastern ..... 3

“Middle ..... 4  
“Western ..... 4”.
