A BILL

To correct spelling errors in the statutory designations of Hawaiian National Parks.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Hawaiian National
5 Park Language Correction Act of 1999”.

6 **SEC. 2. CORRECTIONS IN DESIGNATIONS OF HAWAIIAN NA-**
7 **TIONAL PARKS.**

8 (a) HAWAI`I VOLCANOES NATIONAL PARK.—

9 (1) IN GENERAL.—Public Law 87–278 (75
10 Stat. 577) is amended by striking “Hawaii Volca-

1 noes National Park” each place it appears and in-
2 serting “Hawai`i Volcanoes National Park”.

3 (2) REFERENCES.—Any reference in any law
4 (other than this Act), regulation, document, record,
5 map, or other paper of the United States to “Hawaii
6 Volcanoes National Park” shall be considered a ref-
7 erence to “Hawai`i Volcanoes National Park”.

8 (b) HALEAKALĀ NATIONAL PARK.—

9 (1) IN GENERAL.—Public Law 86–744 (74
10 Stat. 881) is amended by striking “Haleakala Na-
11 tional Park” and inserting “Haleakalā National
12 Park”.

13 (2) REFERENCES.—Any reference in any law
14 (other than this Act), regulation, document, record,
15 map, or other paper of the United States to
16 “Haleakala National Park” shall be considered a
17 reference to “Haleakalā National Park”.

18 (c) KALOKO-HONOKŌHAU.—

19 (1) IN GENERAL.—Section 505 of the National
20 Parks and Recreation Act of 1978 (16 U.S.C. 396d)
21 is amended—

22 (A) in the section heading, by striking
23 “KALOKO-HONOKOHAU” and inserting
24 “KALOKO-HONOKŌHAU”; and

1 (B) by striking “Kaloko-Honokohau” each
 2 place it appears and inserting “Kaloko-
 3 Honokōhau”.

4 (2) REFERENCES.—Any reference in any law
 5 (other than this Act), regulation, document, record,
 6 map, or other paper of the United States to
 7 “Kaloko-Honokohau National Historical Park” shall
 8 be considered a reference to “Kaloko-Honokōhau
 9 National Historical Park”.

10 (d) PU`UHONUA O HŌNAUNAU NATIONAL HISTOR-
 11 ICAL PARK.—

12 (1) IN GENERAL.—The first section of the Act
 13 of July 21, 1955 (chapter 385; 69 Stat. 376), as
 14 amended by section 305 of the National Parks and
 15 Recreation Act of 1978 (92 Stat. 3477), is amended
 16 by striking “Puuhonua o Honaunau National His-
 17 torical Park” and inserting “Pu`uhonua o
 18 Hōnaunau National Historical Park”.

19 (2) REFERENCES.—Any reference in any law
 20 (other than this Act), regulation, document, record,
 21 map, or other paper of the United States to
 22 “Puuhonua o Honaunau National Historical Park
 23 shall be considered a reference to “Pu`uhonua o
 24 Hōnaunau National Historical Park”.

1 (e) PU`UKOHOLĀ HEIAU NATIONAL HISTORICAL
2 SITE.—

3 (1) IN GENERAL.—Public Law 92–388 (86
4 Stat. 562) is amended by striking “Puukohola
5 Heiau National Historical Site” each place it ap-
6 pears and inserting “Pu`ukoholā Heiau National
7 Historical Site”.

8 (2) REFERENCES.—Any reference in any law
9 (other than this Act), regulation, document, record,
10 map, or other paper of the United States to
11 “Puukohola Heiau National Historic Site” shall be
12 considered a reference to “Pu`ukoholā Heiau Na-
13 tional Historical Site”.

14 **SEC. 3. CONFORMING AMENDMENTS.**

15 Section 401(8) of the National Parks and Recreation
16 Act of 1978 (Public Law 95–625; 92 Stat. 3489) is
17 amended by striking “Hawaii Volcanoes” each place it ap-
18 pears and inserting “Hawai`i Volcanoes”.

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
