A BILL

To amend Public Law 105–188 to provide for the mineral leasing of certain Indian lands in Oklahoma.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. MINERAL LEASING OF CERTAIN INDIAN LANDS**

4 **IN OKLAHOMA.**

5 Public Law 105–188 (112 Stat. 620 and 621) is
6 amended—

7 (1) in the title, by inserting “and certain
8 former Indian reservations in Oklahoma” after
9 “Fort Berthold Indian Reservation”; and

10 (2) in section 1—

1 (A) by striking the section heading and in-
2 serting the following:

3 **“SECTION 1. LEASES OF CERTAIN ALLOTTED LANDS.”;**

4 and

5 (B) in subsection (a)(1)(A), by striking
6 clause (i) and inserting the following:

7 “(i) is located within—

8 “(I) the Fort Berthold Indian
9 Reservation in North Dakota; or

10 “(II) a former Indian reservation
11 located in Oklahoma of—

12 “(aa) the Comanche Indian
13 Tribe;

14 “(bb) the Kiowa Indian
15 Tribe;

16 “(cc) the Apache Tribe;

17 “(dd) the Fort Sill Apache
18 Tribe of Oklahoma;

19 “(ee) the Wichita and Affili-
20 ated Tribes (Wichita, Keechi,
21 Waco, and Tawakonie) located in
22 Oklahoma;

23 “(ff) the Delaware Tribe of
24 Western Oklahoma; or

“(gg) the Caddo Indian
