A BILL

To provide technical amendments related to the Vaccine Injury Compensation Trust Fund.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. TECHNICAL AMENDMENTS RELATED TO VAC-**
4 **CINE INJURY COMPENSATION TRUST FUND.**

5 (a) REPEAL OF MUTUALLY CONFLICTING AMEND-
6 MENTS.—

7 (1) IN GENERAL.—Section 1504 of Division C
8 of the Omnibus Consolidated and Emergency Sup-
9 plemental Appropriations Act, 1999 (relating to

1 Vaccine Injury Compensation Trust Fund) is re-
2 pealed.

3 (2) EFFECT OF REPEAL.—The Internal Rev-
4 enue Code of 1986 shall be applied and administered
5 as if the section repealed by paragraph (1) had
6 never been enacted.

7 (b) CONFORMING AMENDMENTS.—Section
8 9510(c)(1) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 (relating
9 to expenditures from Trust Fund) is amended—

10 (1) by striking “August 5, 1997” in subpara-
11 graph (A) and inserting “October 21, 1998”, and

12 (2) by striking “\$9,500,000” in subparagraph
13 (B) and inserting “\$10,000,000”.

14 (c) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendments made by
15 subsection (b) shall take effect as if included in the Omni-
16 bus Consolidated and Emergency Supplemental Appro-
17 priations Act, 1999.
