## RESOLUTION

Designating the month of May each year as the Month  
for Children.

Whereas too often, our children suffer from hunger and  
homelessness;

Whereas the increase in crime in our schools hinders the edu-  
cational development of our children;

Whereas all children should have food, shelter, and health  
care, and should be afforded educational opportunity;

Whereas all children should be protected from abuse and ne-  
glect; and

Whereas the period of childhood for too many children is  
marked by hardship and despair: Now, therefore, be it

1        *Resolved*, That the Senate—

1           (1) designates the month of May each year as  
2 the Month for Children;

3           (2) encourages all Americans to commit them-  
4 selves to improving the lives and future of all chil-  
5 dren by serving as positive role models for the chil-  
6 dren of the United States and the world; and

7           (3) urges community leaders to publicly ac-  
8 knowledge the significant contributions children  
9 make to society.
