CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

Providing for a conditional adjournment of the House of Representatives and a conditional recess or adjournment of the Senate.

1 *Resolved by the House of Representatives (the Senate*
2 *concurring)*, That when the House adjourns on the legisla-
3 tive day of Saturday, January 6, 2001, it stand adjourned
4 until 10 a.m. on Saturday, January 20, 2001; and that
5 when the House adjourns on Saturday, January 20, 2001,

1 it stand adjourned until 2 p.m. on Tuesday, January 30,
2 2001, or until noon on the second day after Members are
3 notified to reassemble pursuant to section 2 of this concur-
4 rent resolution, whichever occurs first; and that when the
5 Senate recesses or adjourns at the close of business on
6 Saturday, January 6, 2001; Sunday, January 7, 2001;
7 Monday, January 8, 2001; Tuesday, January 9, 2001;
8 Wednesday, January 10, 2001; Thursday, January 11,
9 2001; Friday, January 12, 2001; Saturday, January 13,
10 2001; Sunday, January 14, 2001; Monday, January 15,
11 2001; Tuesday, January 16, 2001; Wednesday, January
12 17, 2001; Thursday, January 18, 2001; or Friday, Janu-
13 ary 19, 2001; on a motion offered pursuant to this concur-
14 rent resolution by its Majority Leader or his designee, it
15 stand recessed or adjourned until 10 a.m. on Saturday,
16 January 20, 2001, or until such time on that day as may
17 be specified by its Majority Leader or his designee in the
18 motion to recess or adjourn, or until noon on the second
19 day after Members are notified to reassemble pursuant to
20 section 2 of this concurrent resolution, whichever occurs
21 first.

22 SEC. 2. The Speaker of the House and the Majority
23 Leader of the Senate, acting jointly after consultation with
24 the Minority Leader of the House and the Minority Lead-
25 er of the Senate, shall notify the Members of the House

1 and the Senate, respectively, to reassemble whenever, in
2 their opinion, the public interest shall warrant it.
