A BILL

To provide a grant under the urban park and recreation recovery program to assist in the development of a Millennium Cultural Cooperative Park in Youngstown, Ohio.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. URBAN PARK AND RECREATION RECOVERY**
4 **PROGRAM GRANT FOR NONPROFIT YOUNGS-**
5 **TOWN PLAYHOUSE OF YOUNGSTOWN, OHIO.**

6 (a) GRANT AUTHORITY.—Using funds appropriated
7 or otherwise made available to carry out the Urban Park
8 and Recreation Recovery Act of 1978 (16 U.S.C. 2501
9 et seq.) for fiscal years 2002 through 2006, the Secretary

1 of Interior shall make a grant in each of such fiscal years
2 to the nonprofit Youngstown Playhouse of Youngstown,
3 Ohio, to assist the grant recipient to develop a Millennium
4 Cultural Cooperative Park in Youngstown, Ohio. The
5 amount of the grant for a fiscal year shall be equal to
6 \$2,000,000.

7 (b) TECHNICAL ASSISTANCE.—The Secretary, acting
8 through the National Park Service, shall provide technical
9 assistance to the grant recipient in developing this unique
10 type of urban park.
