## A BILL

To extend the Commission on Affordable Housing and Health Facility Needs for Seniors in the 21st Century and to make technical corrections to the law governing the Commission.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

2       This Act may be cited as the “Senior Housing Com-  
3 mission Extension Act of 2001”.

4 **SEC. 2. EXTENSION OF SENIORS HOUSING AND HEALTH FA-**  
5                   **CILITY NEEDS COMMISSION AND TECHNICAL**  
6                   **CORRECTIONS.**

7       Section 525 of the Departments of Veterans Affairs  
8 and Housing and Urban Development, and Independent  
9 Agencies Appropriations Act, 2000 (42 U.S.C. 12701  
10 note) is amended—

11           (1) in subsection (d)(4), by striking “reimburs-  
12 able” and inserting “non-reimbursable”;

13           (2) in the first sentence of subsection (f)—

14                   (A) by striking “Banking and”; and

15                   (B) by striking “December 31, 2001” and  
16 inserting “December 31, 2002”; and

17           (3) in subsection (g), by striking “June 30,  
18 2002” and inserting “March 31, 2003”.
