Mr. GILCHREST introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on Armed Services

A BILL

To amend title 10, United States Code, to revise the computation of military disability retired pay computation for certain members of the uniformed services injured while a cadet or midshipman at a service academy.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. MILITARY DISABILITY RETIRED PAY COMPUTA-**
4 **TION FOR CERTAIN MEMBERS OF THE UNI-**
5 **FORMED SERVICES INJURED WHILE A CADET**
6 **OR MIDSHIPMAN AT A SERVICE ACADEMY.**

7 (a) IN GENERAL.—(1) Section 1207a(b) of title 10,
8 United States Code, is amended by inserting before the

1 period at the end the following: “or who at the time the
2 disability was incurred was a cadet at the United States
3 Military Academy, the United States Air Force Academy,
4 or the Coast Guard Academy or a midshipman at the
5 United States Naval Academy”.

6 (2) Section 1208 of such title is amended by adding
7 at the end the following new subsection:

8 “(c) A member of the armed forces who at the time
9 the member’s disability was incurred was a cadet at the
10 United States Military Academy, the United States Air
11 Force Academy, or the Coast Guard Academy or a mid-
12 shipman at the United States Naval Academy shall be
13 credited, for the purposes of this chapter, with the number
14 of years of service the member performed as a cadet or
15 midshipman.”.

16 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendments made by
17 subsection (a) shall apply only with respect to persons who
18 are retired under chapter 61 of title 10, United States
19 Code, on or after the date of the enactment of this Act.
