A BILL

2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. REEMPLOYMENT OPPORTUNITY FOR RECIPI-**
2 **ENTS OF VOLUNTARY SEPARATION INCEN-**
3 **TIVE PAYMENTS UNDER DEPARTMENT OF**
4 **AGRICULTURE PROGRAM.**

5 Section 735(e) of the Agriculture, Rural Develop-
6 ment, Food and Drug Administration, and Related Agen-
7 cies Appropriations Act, 1997 (Public Law 104–180; 110
8 Stat. 1604; 5 U.S.C. 5597 note) is amended—

9 (1) by striking “An individual” and inserting
10 the following:

11 “(1) FORFEITURE OF INCENTIVE PAYMENT.—
12 An individual”; and

13 (2) by adding at the end the following new
14 paragraph:

15 “(2) EXCEPTION.—The forfeiture requirement
16 in paragraph (1) shall not apply if the subsequent
17 employment or personal services contract is directly
18 related to fighting forest fires.”.
