A BILL

To clarify the ability of members of the National Capital Planning Commission to serve after the expiration of their terms until successor members are appointed, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. TERMS OF SERVICE OF MEMBERS OF NA-**
4 **TIONAL CAPITAL PLANNING COMMISSION.**

5 (a) TIMING OF EXPIRATION OF TERMS.—Section
6 2(b)(2) of the Act entitled “An Act providing for a com-
7 prehensive development of the park and playground sys-
8 tem of the National Capital”, approved June 6, 1924 (40

1 U.S.C. 71a(b)(2); sec. 2-1002(b)(2), D.C. Official Code)
2 is amended by inserting immediately before “Any person
3 appointed” the following: “The term of a member ap-
4 pointed under this paragraph shall expire on April 30 of
5 the final year of the term.”.

6 (b) CONTINUATION OF SERVICE.—Section 2(b)(2) of
7 such Act (40 U.S.C. 71a(b)(2); sec. 2-1002(b)(2), D.C.
8 Official Code) is amended by inserting immediately before
9 “Any person appointed” the following: “ A member of the
10 Commission appointed under this paragraph may serve
11 after the expiration of the member’s term until a successor
12 has taken office.”.

13 **SEC. 2. EFFECTIVE DATE.**

14 The amendments made by section 1—

15 (1) in the case of the amendment made by sec-
16 tion 1(a), shall apply with respect to members serv-
17 ing on the National Capital Planning Commission on
18 or after the date of the enactment of this Act; and

19 (2) in the case of the amendment made by sec-
20 tion 1(b), shall be deemed to have taken effect July
21 1, 1974.
