A BILL

To modify requirements relating to allocation of interest that accrues to the Abandoned Mine Reclamation Fund.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Coal Accountability
5 and Retired Employee Act for the 21st Century”.

1 **SEC. 2. TREATMENT OF ABANDONED MINE RECLAMATION**
2 **FUND INTEREST.**

3 Notwithstanding any other provision of law, any in-
4 terest credited to the fund established by section 401 of
5 the Surface Mining Control and Reclamation Act of 1977
6 (30 U.S.C. 1231) shall be transferred to the Combined
7 Fund identified in section 402(h)(2) of such Act (30
8 U.S.C. 1232(h)(2)) in such amounts as are estimated by
9 the trustees of such Combined Fund to offset the amount
10 of any deficit in net assets in the Combined Fund.
