Mr. JONES of North Carolina introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on Armed Services

A BILL

To amend title 37, United States Code, to provide a dislocation allowance under section 407 of such title to retired members of the uniformed services and members on the temporary disability retired list moving from their last duty station to their designated home.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Military Retiree Dis-
5 location Assistance Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. ELIGIBILITY OF CERTAIN MEMBERS FOR DISLOCA-**
2 **TION ALLOWANCE WHEN ORDERED FROM**
3 **MEMBER'S LAST DUTY STATION TO MEM-**
4 **BER'S HOME.**

5 (a) **ELIGIBILITY FOR PRIMARY DISLOCATION AL-**
6 **LOWANCE.**—Subsection (a)(2) of section 407 of title 37,
7 United States Code, is amended by adding at the end the
8 following new subparagraph:

9 “(H) A member who is retired, or placed on a
10 temporary disability retired list, under chapter 61 of
11 title 10, and the member’s dependents actually move
12 to a home selected by the member in accordance
13 with section 404(e)(2) of this title.”.

14 (b) **CONFORMING AMENDMENT.**—Subsection (e) of
15 such section is amended by inserting “(except as provided
16 in subsection (a)(2)(H))” before the period at the end.

17 (c) **APPLICATION OF AMENDMENTS.**—The amend-
18 ments made by this section shall apply with respect to a
19 member of the uniformed services who is retired, or placed
20 on a temporary disability retired list, under chapter 61
21 of title 10, United States Code, at any time after the end
22 of the 60-day period beginning on the date of the enact-
23 ment of this Act.
