3 **SECTION 1. DESIGNATION OF FRANK SINATRA POST**

4 **OFFICE BUILDING.**

5 The facility of the United States Postal Service lo-
6 cated at 89 River Street in Hoboken, New Jersey, shall

1 be known and designated as the “Frank Sinatra Post Of-
2 fice Building”.

3 **SEC. 2. REFERENCES.**

4 Any reference in a law, map, regulation, document,
5 paper, or other record of the United States to the facility
6 referred to in section 1 shall be deemed to be a reference
7 to the Frank Sinatra Post Office Building.
