1 **SECTION 1. DESIGNATION OF JAMES A. MCCLURE FEDERAL**
2 **BUILDING AND UNITED STATES COURT-**
3 **HOUSE.**

4 The Federal building and United States courthouse
5 located at 550 West Fort Street in Boise, Idaho, shall be
6 known and designated as the “James A. McClure Federal
7 Building and United States Courthouse”.

8 **SEC. 2. REFERENCES.**

9 Any reference in a law, map, regulation, document,
10 paper, or other record of the United States to the Federal
11 building and United States courthouse referred to in sec-
12 tion 1 shall be deemed to be a reference to the James
13 A. McClure Federal Building and United States Court-
14 house.
