A BILL

For the relief of Thomas J. Sansone, Jr.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. COMPENSATION FOR VACCINE-RELATED IN-**
4 **JURY.**

5 (a) CAUSE OF INJURY.—In consideration of the peti-
6 tion filed under subtitle 2 of title XXI of the Public Health
7 Service Act (42 U.S.C. 300aa–10 et seq.) (relating to the
8 National Vaccine Injury Compensation Program) by the
9 legal representatives of Thomas J. Sansone, Jr., including
10 the claims contained in that petition that the injury de-
11 scribed in that petition was caused by a vaccine covered

1 in the Vaccine Injury Table specified in section 2114 of
2 such Act (42 U.S.C. 300aa–14) and given on June 1,
3 1994, such injury is deemed to have been caused by such
4 vaccine for the purposes of subtitle 2 of title XXI of such
5 Act.

6 (b) PAYMENT.—The Secretary of Health and Human
7 Services shall pay compensation to Thomas J. Sansone,
8 Jr. for the injury referred to in subsection (a) in accord-
9 ance with section 2115 of the Public Health Service Act
10 (42 U.S.C. 300aa–15).
