3 **SECTION 1. EXTENSION OF DUTY SUSPENSION ON 3,5-**
4 **DIBROMO-4-HYDOXYBENZONITRIL.**

5 (a) IN GENERAL.—Subheading 9902.38.18 of the
6 Harmonized Tariff Schedule of the United States is
7 amended by striking “2003” and inserting “2005”.

8 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendment made by
9 subsection (a) applies with respect to goods entered, or
