## A BILL

To suspend temporarily the duty on certain textile machinery.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3       **SECTION 1. CERTAIN TEXTILE MACHINERY.**

4       (a) IN GENERAL.—Subchapter II of chapter 99 of  
5       the Harmonized Tariff Schedule of the United States is  
6       amended by striking heading 9902.84.10 and inserting in  
7       numerical sequence the following new heading:

“	9902.84.10	Power weaving machines (looms), shuttle type, for weaving fabrics of a width exceeding 30 cm but not exceeding 4.9 m (provided for in sub-heading 8446.21.50), if entered without off-loom or large loom take-ups, drop wires, heddles, reeds, harness frames, or beams .....	Free	No change	No change	On or before 12/31/2005	”.

1           (b) **EFFECTIVE DATE.**—The amendment made by  
2 subsection (a) shall apply to goods entered, or withdrawn  
3 from warehouse for consumption, on or after the date that  
4 is 15 days after the date of enactment of this Act.
